Peter Gibbs: Newcastle Ambassador & Founder of IPROWD



Peter Gibbs is a Gamillaroi man from the tiny village of Weilmoringle in the far west of NSW, he grew up in what could be described as a semi traditional life. Peter's Great Grandfather Jack Orcher had a vision for his family - that Peter's Generation would be educated and as Weilmoringle School only went to Year 6, that only meant one thing boarding school! In 1978 off he went with some of his other relatives to a Catholic Boarding School at Forbes in Central West NSW. He's the eldest son of Peter Gibbs & Margaret Orcher. His mum passed away due to cancer in 1977, he has two brothers but sadly his only sister passed way also just 28. His sister's TRAGIC death in a Police cell in Brewarrina in 1997 was the catalyst for what we now know as the IPROWD Program, which is now State-wide, has trained over 600 Aboriginal people with many now working for NSW Police as Sworn and Unsworn Officers. Peter has worked for many State & Federal Agencies, he's been a former Federal Government Ministerial Advisor treading the hallways of Canberra and he's been on numerous boards & committees. Peter previously worked for TAFE NSW leading the IPROWD program and currently works as Senior Advisor for the Hon Sarah Mitchell -Minister for Early Childhood Education, Minister for Aboriginal Affairs and the Assistant Minister for Education.

We place the future of this city and her people in your hands knowing you are a faithful God.


We stand together in unity and call upon you to bless this city and protect all in it LORD.
